- 1 Whiz the fruit together in a mixer until smooth.
- 2 Pour into a silicone egg mould until halfway full.
- 3 Freeze for 30 minutes to an hour.
- 4 Pour plain yoghurt onto the frozen fruit mix until it reaches the top of the mould.
- 5 Freeze for at least 2 hours.
